國際著名建築、室内及產品設計師梁志天於 1957 年出生於香港,善於 將饒富亞洲文化及藝術的元素融入其設計中。他在 1987 年創立建築及城市規劃顧問公司,並於 1997 年把公司重組,成立梁志天建築師有限 公司 (SLA) 及梁志天設計師有限公司 (SLD)。以「設計 無界限」(Design Without Limits) 為目標,於 2014 年及 2015 年期間成立三大新品牌公 司 — 《梁志天酒店設計有限公司 (SLH)、梁志天國際有限公司 (SLX) 及梁志天生活藝術有限公司 (SLL),讓設計服務漸趨多樣化、專門化 並於 2007 年成立「1957 & Co.」品牌,以完美生活為目標,進軍餐飲 業,透過名元化的發展,全面實踐「享受生活,享受設計」的生活理念。 2015 年,梁志天於被譽有室内設計奥斯卡的「Andrew Martin 國際室内 設計大概」由問題「全球任度大概」;同任亦被設計雜誌《INTERNI設 計時代》甄選成為「2015 INTERNI 全球設計權力榜」中全球最具影響 力的 50 位設計師之一;及獲《福布斯》中文版發佈的「中國最且影響 力設計師榜單」中選定為 30 強;作品更囊括超過 130 項國際和亞太區 設計及企業獎項。近年,更數度獲繳擔任業界權威設計大獎的評委,包 括亞太室内設計大獎、iF Design Award China、德國紅點產品設計大獎、 China Property Awards 及 iF Communication Design Award 。現為國 際室内建築師/設計師聯盟 (IFI) 2015-2017 年度候任主席暨 2017 年度 主席、中國室内裝飾協會設計專業委員會執行主任

Steve Leung was born in 1957 in Hong Kong and is well known for works fused in dynamic cultures from Asia to Australia. He found a city design and architectural firm in 1987 and restricted the names to SLA and SLD in 1997. The firm expanded and eventually divided into three firms -SLH, SLX, and SLI, to provide full professional design consulting service

In 2015. Steve Leung won the Andrew Martin Interior Design Award. which is laureate award in the Interior Design ring. He was also selected by "INTERNI - Age of Design" Magazine as one of the fifty most influential designers in the world. In Forbes Chinese edition, he was listed as one of thirty of the most influential designers in China. He has peen invited to be a juror for if Design Award China, Asian Interior Design Award, Red dot Award, China Property Awards and if Communicat Design Award. He will be the chairman for IFI in 2017 and is the curren director for the Interior Decoration and Design Associa

生活體驗能啟發設計創作,從中展現個人記憶菁華,進而引導居住者參與這些美好回憶。此作是設計師梁志天將巴黎左 岸的美好回憶植生至亞洲城市的新嘗試,空間基地位於香港核心地段,是都會高樓的一戶頂層複式單位,正如巴黎精華寓 所般擁有交通四通八達、閒適的綠化景觀,室內可享開揚視野,瞰望環境風光。在香港這座城市住宅裡,梁志天引用色彩 作為觸媒,觸動居住者內心同感那些似曾相識的巴黎記憶,進而繫連空間與城市印象。

設計師表示,此作在結構調整上主要做了兩項處理,一是一樓由於需要兼顧天花板及橫樑等建築結構,致使樓梯區天花板 變得相對較矮,所以利用飾條與間接光源修飾結構,梯座亦由原本的鏤空鋼構改為雲石砌造,梯下變更成儲物空間提升收 納機能。此外,因應家庭成員需求,二樓書房以一道雙摺玻璃門與起居廳輕輕劃界,藉以營造舒適的閱讀、工作空間,並 日維繫室內的開闊感,一樓客房的浴室亦採取類似手法將實牆改為玻璃隔間。基地戶外具有景觀優勢,設計師特意為每一 樓層保留大片落地玻璃窗,並且確保窗前家具的高度、距離不會遮擋窗外景色,引人不時看望遼闊的球場景觀,將綠草如 茵的清新景致揉入日常之中。頂層天臺更強化居高臨下的暢朗視野,此區配置舒適愜意的戶外家具和燒烤爐,作為屋主與 親友舉行派對的理想空間,周邊再加入綠化植物美化環境,並且充當遮飾屏風與毗連鄰舍相分隔,維護天臺活動的私密性。

另一特色,是設計師以巴黎塞納河左岸的精緻典雅作靈感,淬取成獨特的視覺語彙融入空間之中。全作可見冷冽的灰色 調與華麗鏡像、反射或水晶材質共同演造虛實變化,彷彿在誘人拋開侷限視野,進入一個亦真亦夢的感官旅程。灰色主調 貫徹了各個樓層,在空間蘊蓄出一股冷凝的優雅,對於設計師而言,中性灰並非意味著模糊曖昧,而是明確的意有所指: 它摩登又古典,正如同巴黎長年薈萃的文化品味與藝術氣息。此作除了以深灰色基調烘托氛圍,也運用大量的深藍、黑色 滲入細節,透過多種深邃色調覆蓋空間之手法,與落地窗外的明媚風光構成反差效果,襯托都會的繽紛景色。


在裝飾造型上,所有物件的線條比例都被刻意簡約化,運用猶若剪影般的對比輪廓鬆緩視感距離,消弭原本格局緻密的 侷促情景。另一方面,每座場域看似獨立構景,卻又具有彼此相似的元素,窗景、藝術與靜物等配置均十分注重相應關係, 自細節佈下色彩、線條的對應脈絡,在彼此遙相呼應之中,令空間有如古典油畫般呈現飽滿豐美的視覺內涵,產生擬似「畫 中畫」之趣味效應。

設計詮釋可以作為理解新生活的途徑,它讓人體驗無限可能。在此作,設計師以特定城市作為靈感,自構景、造型、色 彩埋下層層線索,諸多巴黎元素經由咀嚼轉換與亞洲寓所相連結,從中交織了客觀的城市意象與設計者的內在綺想,領人 彷彿漫遊在巴黎私邸,交錯了不同時空的生活情節,更拓展了居住者對於生活的諸多期許。採訪」劉蕙蘋

This apartment unit design reveals how Steve's memory turns to imagined pictures and transforms the unit into collage from a Parisian impression. The unit is a double floor unit set on high level floors. The vivid colors are like a street scene of a medieval district scene in Left Bank Paris through which Steve has introduced an energetic space as something of a residue of his memory.

Several existing conditions were initially confronted and some needed to be strongly modified within the existing plan to get the best interior quality. On the lower level, Steve added many horizontal bands on the ceiling to reduce the stress and insufficient ceiling height caused by hidden utility pipes. The formation of the staircase was also changed to create enough storage space. The upper level has a new sliding door that separates the private bedrooms and a transitional living quarter. A similar sliding door also appears in the guest room on the lower level.

The most unique feature of the unit rests on the grand windows and ample balconies which are quite a good space for gathering and entertaining the family members by the green plantings. Relaxed outdoor furniture pieces and a barbecue oven wait for moments of gathering. Garden bushes were planted to provide perfect privacy control from the neighboring unit.

Steve intentionally used Paris as an inspiring impression for this unit; the space is full of contrasting color between s winter's chilling gray and summer's flamboyantly colors. The material mingles in a reflective crystal surface and heavy solid bodies travel a long history. Paris is a paradigm of contemporary cities; it is modern but classical, conservative but avantgarde. With the strong color contrasts Steve used blues and blacks to balance the strong dialogue among several strong colors. The colors receive natural light in a very sharp and impressive tone, and perfectly interprets a long-waited tranquil moment in a modern city.

All furnishing elements are not lavish in decoration but rather the decorative motifs are reduced into the simplest formation. The arrangement of furniture pieces provides each space with a unique ambience yet they are still have something in common. Art collections such as paintings harmonize with other elements in each space and the visual gaze towards the paintings find that they are set in positions that intentionally provide a strong perspective wonderment as if the space is the big frame of a piece of art.


