

利用空間裡的穿透感與輕量感,將窗外的山谷、綠地、藍天、日光引入室內, 讓使用者真切感受棲居於自然的珍貴價值。

「山居」,屋如其名,是一座 位在山區,面朝山谷的獨棟透天 別墅。屋主擇此而居,期待環境 自然氣息滲透於日常之中,享有 怡享悠然的脫塵之境。面對一家 四口生活需求,如何以空間體現 環境氛圍,同時切合當代生活機 能,是本案的設計重點。



「通透」與「縫隙」

張育睿建築師表示,「通透」與「縫隙」是此作設計的核心概念。主因有二:一是 考量台灣山區氣候潮濕、變化大,藉由空間裡的大小開口,促進光照與氣流暢通,利 用自然力量調節空間氣候。其二,則是回應此作為「山上的房子」之特色,希望表現 出徜徉於大自然的自由無拘,讓使用者、空間與生活都能緊扣環境、面向自然。

在平面佈局上,將 1 樓整塑為層次豐富的公共空間,藉由場域之間的中介地帶,為屬域關係建構舒鬆亦緊密的曖昧感受,既保有個人舒適的活動領域,視線上又能時時關照家人動態。對外,打開四面立牆,將環境山景納入室內,使家居生活面朝山谷景致,居室感受不再封閉。外部再設立平台圍繞建築量體,創造室內、外的中介空間,將居室體感延伸至戶外,淡化內、外分界,將生活浸入自然懷抱裡。

室內空間運用「縫隙」令整體更形輕透,利用硬體不同面向、尺度的開口連繫場域與裡外關係,使日光、氣流與環境景緻都能在空間裡流動穿梭,也由於引入不同方位的光照,更加豐滿了空間質感。

在細節上,設計師進一步使物件、造型輕量化, 降低室內彩度,以大地色系貫徹全作自然舒適的氣 息,讓低斂背景突顯出居室裡流竄的自然光影與生 活動態,當人穿梭於空間裡,視野能夠領受豐富的 內外景象,身心沐浴在四季時序的變化之中。


「多進」與「迴遊」

全作另項重點,是以「多進」手法為空間創造豐富層次。設計師談到,由於原有的建築結構為加強磚造,基於結構安全考量,承重牆的部分不可更動,在此前提下仍然希望提高整體開放感受,因此建立了迴遊式動線賦予路徑自由,並且發展出「多進」的佈局規劃,藉由中介領域為空間創造多樣化使用的可能。

1 樓個室用玻璃滑軌門片作為區隔,穿廊盡頭視 庭院為端景,放大廊道體感並且補入採光,廊間除 了是賞景路徑,當玻璃門片收攏後也能與個室連合 為休憩小區。2 樓利用夾層過道拓寬房區走廊,它 是私密區與公共區域的中介空間,提供觀景、休憩 的共享平台,同時也是起居廳的延伸,為空間創造 多樣化使用的可能。

正如「山居」主題,全案軟硬體以自然氛圍貫徹,空間裡高度的穿透感與輕量感,將窗外的山谷、綠地、藍天、日光引入家居日常,讓使用者真切感受到棲居於自然的珍貴價值。採訪」室內雜誌編輯部


Mountain Residence is a villa facing a valley surrounded by nature. The challenge for the design was to both take advantage of the natural views and offer all living conveniences with the necessary appliances and furnishings.

Transparency and Void

Transparency and void are the two core ideas of the design for addressing the high humidity and sharp differences in temperature. Natural light and air flow are essential to modify the micro-temperature in the space. Transparency also allows the visual link in and out freely and living in the space can feel fully immersed into nature.

The first floor is for public use but several ambiguous elements link one space to the other. Major view side windows are intentionally expanded to display a grand view to nature. A wood balcony that accepts the direct physical link to the interior blur the border between indoor and outdoor.

Voids create openings in the spatial layout that expedite the air flow and permeation of light. Furnishing objects all use light weight supporting systems to reduce the vertical volume that usually blocks the light path. The earthy color interior makes good dialogue with light and shade and the light responds to the interior by following the four seasons in a rich rhythm.





Layering and Twisting

The Ilano layout creates a rich layering system in the spatial rhythm. Because the load bearing walls could not be removed the design was forced to yield several nebulous zones to allow the light to spread from one space to the others. This twisting walking path yields an experience like wondering in a maze.

The first floor has a glass sliding door and a path hidden behind ends in a vista view. The closing of the glass panel creates a tranquil corner in intimate comfort. The second floor is mostly designated to private use except at the mezzanine level that is used by all members for daily relaxing comfort.

Nature is the most essential element in the design, and the effort of the work mostly focused on pondering the ways to properly store valley view, hills, greenery, sky and natural light.

溝通重點 Communication Note ■

本案居住成員為小家庭,建築是一獨棟透天別墅,屋齡 40 年,基地位於山區,面臨山谷。屋主希望居家能體現自然環境,考量山區較易潮濕,因此利用「開放」、「通透」與「縫隙」手法重理空間,利用通暢氣流調節居室氣候,並且創造自由動線與空間彈性,讓使用者、空間及生活能面向自然、體驗自然。

The project is a single house for four family members. The house was built 40 years ago, and required a total transformation for living comfort and better control of the micro-weather condition. The renovated plan absorbs natural light and expedites air flows to evict humidity. The plan is open with rich visual layering without being blocked by partition walls.
